Founded in 1917, Celler el Masroig is one of the most important wineries in Montsant. It encompasses approximately 500 hectares of vineyards, and is one of the largest wineries within the DO. Today, Masroig looks to the future with a determination to continue the path of improvement and transformation started in recent years. The winery of the 21st century is working tirelessly to uphold the trust of its customers, making quality and tradition the stamp of identity.

Designation of Origin: Montsant. Vineyards spread out across dramatic hills, sharing the slopes with pines, almond and olive trees. Despite this Designation of Origin surrounds the Priorat DOQ in the shape of a shoehorse, its wines have a strong personality.

Varietals: 100 % Garnatxa Blanca.

Winemaking: First days of fermentation in stainless steel tanks, and it finishes in new French oak barrels with battonage method.

Ageing: 5 months in French oak.

Tasting note: Bright golden coloured. Complex on the nose with Mediterranean herbs, white flowers, lemongrass, at the back some toasted and creamy notes. Elegance and roundness in the mouth. Large, complex and persistent.
