Salvador Dalí and Miguel Mateu, businessman, sponsor of culture and founder of the Perelada winery, held a close friendship throughout their lives. The universal Catalan painter was a regular guest at the castle that his friend had bought in 1923. He painted and made some speeches there.

Perelada and the Gala-Salvador Dalí Foundation wants to pay tribute to Dalí with this Torre Galatea Reserva. A wine that summarizes the Empordà essence, a reflection of its soils and its climate. An environment where the artist lived for most of his life and which was an inspiration for many of his master works.

Tasting Note

Dark cherry red color

Aroma with hints of red fruits and spices, balsamic notes and a roasted background.

The palate is round. Fresh, structured and balanced.

It has some tannins present but very well integrated, and the acidity provides it a lot of aging capacity.
